## Bring:

- · 1 pad Arches Oil paper (16"x12")

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- · 1 pad of drawing paper or sketchbook—size should be at least 11"x14"

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- o Or similar...lots to choose from. Need not be heavy or expensive paper—these are for exercises.
- · 3 multi-media artboards OR wood painting panels, all the same size—should be 11" to 16" per side (examples: 12"x12", 14"x11", 16"x16"). Need not be cradled panels. Please gesso the surface of unprimed wood panels beforehand if you choose those.

- · Selection of oil paint, your choice—include warm and cool colors, transparent and opaque, dark and light colors. A large tube of titanium white is advised.

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- · Selection of several R&F pigment sticks—your choice of color

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- · Several sticks of compressed charcoal plus any other drawing materials you like—for example: soft pencil, markers, oil pastel (for use on paper)
- · Palette paper or hard palette
- · Soft Brayer: SP Create brand preferred--2"-4" (No Speedball brayers.)

- · Squeegee (s): SP Create brand preferred--small to medium size. Messermiester brand bowl scrapers are also fine.

- · Palette knife: trowel type, flat blade (avoid pointed ends)

- · A few brushes of your choice for solvent techniques
- · Roll of wax paper
- · Roll of removable tape for taping edges of paper—1" wide or less
- · Gloves for keeping hands clean (optional)
- · Cardboard the size of your panels to protect work for your travel home (optional)
- · Anything you think would incise interesting marks (skewers, dish scrubbers, wire brush, etc.)
